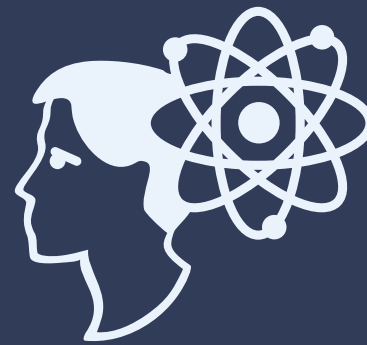


Dara School invites you to attend
